FISCAL MANAGEMENT

Funding Channel

The consortium has chosen direct funding

Rationale

The Kern AEBG Consortium functioned under the Fiscal Agent model with the Kern Community College District functioning as the Fiscal Agent during the 2015-16 year. The fiscal structure for the 2016-17 year was brought to the consortium board for review and discussion at the March 29, 2016 board meeting. Members examined the advantages and disadvantages of both a Fiscal Agent model and a Direct Funding structure; discussion was held as to how the two structures impact small and large districts and the advantages and disadvantages to both. During continued discussion at the Kern AEBG Board meeting on April 13, members expressed a desire to move to a Direct Funding model which they felt would "expedite and streamline" the delivery of consortium funds to the members. A shared responsibility for the funding for consortium level management such as the Project Director position, certain administrative costs, data collection, and the rolling up of data was discussed and agreed upon. Thus, by unanimous vote at the April 13th Board meeting, the consortium elected become a Direct Funded consortium for the 2016-17 year.

Approach

As the Fiscal Agent for the Kern AEBG, the Kern Community College District has been responsible for disbursement of member allocations in a timely manner as well as programmatic and fiscal report submissions to the state. As the Fiscal Agent, KCCD has been responsible for timely disbursement of all checks to members. John Means, Associate Chancellor of Economic and Workforce Development, has served as the programmatic lead responsible for the timely submission of program reports while Carlene Feichter, Accounting Manager, has been responsible for the submission of fiscal reports. Carlene Feichter reports to Thomas J. Burke, Chief Financial Officer and the consortium's certifying official. All reported data has been provided by members along with appropriate supporting documentation (i.e.: invoices, purchase orders, etc.) and prepared for delivery to Feichter who prepares final documents to be rolled up for submission to the state by the Chief Financial Officer, Thomas J. Burke. In order to prepare detailed information for reporting to the state, each member has prepared a Scope of Work identifying by program, object code, and objective any and all intended to purchases for the year. This information has been uploaded into an electronic database in order that all purchases may be reconciled against a consortium-approved Scope of Work plan. As the consortium moves to a Direct Funding model, the Project Director will gather and coordinate all documentation for state reporting while the individual members will maintain appropriate documentation for all expenditures. Data points will be gathered by the Project Director. Tom Burke, will continue to be the consortium's certifying official.

Funding Changes

The Kern AEBG Consortium received \$143,532 in additional funds for the 16-17 year. Muroc Joint Unified School District, under new leadership, sought membership in the consortium for the 16-17 year and subsequently requested approximately \$50,000 to reopen their adult education program. Discussion was opened at the March 29 board meeting regarding Muroc's request as well as plans for distribution of the additional funds. During the May 28, 2016 Board meeting, Muroc was approved as a member and subsequently allocated \$52,000 from the consortium fund.

Consensus and Approval Process

All Kern Consortium members submitted a detailed work plan for the projects they intended to develop during 2015-16. All documents were reviewed for alignment to the activities proposed in Tables 3.1, 4.1, 5.1, 6.1, and 7.1 of the 3-Year Plan. The corresponding tables in the Annual Plan for 2015-16 reflect these plans. Additionally, all work plans were submitted with budgets broken out by the 1000's category. All projects in current development are in alignment with both the 3-Year Plan and the Annual Plan. Additionally, the consortium plans to review and certify all member work plans for 2016-17 prior to submission of the consortium's Year 2 Annual Plan 2016-17.
