After many hours of negotiation and collaboration between active consortium members and College of Marin, fiscal subcontracts, MOU's have recently been approved which will allow funding to pass through more seamlessly in 2016-17.

Approach

Block Grant Fiscal

Management: As Fiscal Agent, COM designates a portion of all monthly

governance meetings to discussing invoice procedures, pass-through process, requirements,

state reporting, activities of consortia colleagues specific to funding and related questions. Designated consortium workshops and individual agency meetings with Fiscal Agent accounting representatives are

planned and will ensure funding to flow seamlessly between agencies.
