#### **Funding Channel**

#### Rationale

This is a consensus decision among the member districts. The overwhelming reason to remain with a fiscal agent is the ease of reporting. We also believe that having a single fiscal agent facilitates cooperation and minimizes error.

#### Approach

At our Leadership Council meetings, an ongoing agenda item is fiscal updates. During that portion of our meeting, all members review planned v. actual expenditures. We also discuss upcoming reporting deadlines and agree on actions to adhere to those deadlines. Our fiscal agent provides reporting spreadsheets to each member in order to be able to aggregate the data and report expenditures for the overall grant to the State.

#### **Funding Changes**

No major changes. Increases are in accordance with our plan and the timeline for staffing in relation to that plan. Funds held by the fiscal agent that were unspent in 2015-16 have been distributed to members in accordance with the plan. Some of the allocations in both 2015-16 and for 2016-17 are for one-time expenses. The increase to Vista's allocation is attributed to the funds allocated to Vista, as our fiscal agent. Please note: because we do have one time expenses, and because we have attributed the fiscal agent funding to Vista, we do not expect the funding to each member to be the same in 2017-18.

# Consensus and Approval Process

When the Leadership Council developed our annual plan for 2015-16 and our three-year plan, we had agreed upon the priorities for funding and a timeline for implementation of activities to support the seven program areas and populations. The distribution schedule follows that initial plan with only minor updates based on real costs and expenditures. Each member reported its expenditures for the prior year and made requests for 2016-17. Those requests were prioritized and funded based on available funding. All members reached consensus for funding the distribution schedule. The distribution schedule was approved at a public meeting on Friday, April 29, 2016.

## OTHER RULES AND PROCEDURES

#### Additional Information

Note: The previous distribution schedule includes both one-time expenses and the amount allocated to the fiscal agent to contract with entities on behalf of the consortium. For example, and in accordance with our plan, our fiscal agent is contracting with a public information/marketing firm and a research firm. Additionally, the fiscal agent will be providing funding for the annual retreat and community forums held on behalf of the consortium members. We expect there to be variances in members' allocations from year-to-year in accordance with our adopted budget (which outlines one-time, short-term, and fiscal agent expenses).
