The consortium has designated a fiscal agent

Rationale

RAE's service area covers two geographically large yet rural counties. Membership includes the eight school districts with secondary programs. Two of those districts received MOE funding in 2015-2016. Del Norte Unified has agreed to return their funding to the Consortium. Eureka City Schools has managed their funds during the 2015-2016 fiscal year. So the vast majority of the funds were to flow through the college to begin with. Eureka City Schools is interested in discussing returning their MOE funds for 2016-2017 to the consortium and having RAE manage all the Adult Education programs Humboldt and Del Norte Counties.

Early in the planning process, the Executive Committee reached consensus to have CR serve as the Fiscal Agent given the lack of remaining Adult Education programs running in the CR service area at the onset of AB86 planning. For our region, the overwhelming benefit has been the consortium's ability to create unified and geographically balanced programs in ABE, GED Prep, and ESL during the 2015-2016 fiscal year. With the grant truly being managed by the college, having the college maintain the fiscal responsibilities was a logical decision. Being a small community, a great deal of trust already existed amongst the membership, built on a long history of working together on various other projects.

Approach

All grant expenditures are first approved by the RAE Executive Committee. Since College of the Redwoods is the Fiscal Agent, all expenditures, including salaries and benefits, are managed by the Business Office, following all the established laws and protocols. Prudence Ratliff, in the CR Business Office, maintains the ongoing costs associated with our grant. She is responsible for populating the quarterly and annual report spreadsheets, which are reviewed by the Assistant Director of Adult Education prior to submission.
