Funding Changes

The funds previously allocated to the fiscal agent for fiscal administration of the grant were re-allocated to member agencies.

Consensus and Approval Process

The Consortium Work Group met several times to determine appropriate allocations. Starting with the 15/16 allocations, we then re-allocated to member agencies monies that had been allocated to the fiscal agent in order to fiscally administer the grant during 15-16. We then determined the costs for the Program Director, consortium-wide activities such as maintaining a website, marketing, program area activities, staff development, etc. Additional amounts for the consortium-wide activities were allocated to specific member agencies who will be fiscally responsible for these activities. All members understand AEBG's focus on the seven program areas and have agreed to report regularly during 2016-2017 on their expenditures and how they are addressing the program areas. All members and partners participated in the work group meetings and mutually agreed on the outcome. Work Group recommendations were presented to all members, partners, and stakeholders through emails and at public Coordinating Council meetings, and were approved by the RHRAEC Executive Board.
