Funding Changes

	<p>Tulare City School District is listed on this CFAD. The LEA is not a SAEC member. As a LEA that does not provide adult education services, Tulare City School District did not receive MOE funding in 2015.14. SAEC will utilize a direct funding model. Visalia Unified School District housed the Regional Integrated Delivery System (RISDS) as the fiscal agent. RISDS provides pan consortium strategy implementation to support SAEC objectives in all program areas. Visalia Unified School District will continue to provide the RISDS strategy and receive funding to support this strategy. Funds for RISDS had been held by the fiscal agent (VUSD) with direct oversight by the SAEC Board. The RISDS funds will continue to be part of the VUSD allocation. Members will decrease their overall allocation for 2016.17 to support other strategies that will be implemented consortium wide through the RISDS structure. The funds relinquished by members will be directed back to VUSD to implement the pan consortium strategies through RISDS.</p>
Consensus and Approval Process	<p>SAEC reached a unanimous vote to establish consensus at a regularly scheduled board meeting to approve the 2016.17 allocation scheduled. The 2016.17 allocation schedule was determined by SAEC voting members pursuant to Section 84913 of the California Education Code.</p>

Additional Information

SAEC will utilize a direct funding model for the 2016.17 implementation year. Consortium strategic coordination and strategy delivery for those strategies that reach across SAEC will be funded and provided through Visalia Unified School District as part of the RISDS structure. SAEC budget planning, expenditure data, and performance data will be provided to the state by the SAEC director. Member districts will continue to report budget and performance data through the SAEC director and the RISDS strategy. Governance is not otherwise changed.
