# FISCAL MANAGEMENT

Funding Channel

The consortium has designated a fiscal agent

#### Rationale

The West Hills Consortium selected to continue operating with West Hills Community College district as the fiscal agent for the upcoming 2016-17 year. To date, this format has worked for all members; all members received an initial \$20,000 advance to assist with start-up cost and no members have sent in invoicing asking for any additional funds yet. It is anticipated invoicing will begin very soon.

The decision to continue with this format was unanimous and no one shared any concerns. It was shared that confidence was with West Hills as they had the most experience dealing with reporting and large grants.

The fiscal contact, Maria Battisti and lead assigned accountant attended a recent meeting to share copies of forms and billing samples to assist; descriptions were shared along with timelines for reporting.

Approach

The AEBG block grant is being fiscally managed by West Hills Community College District (WHCCD). An accountant has been assigned to maintain all fiscal information and track all expenditures. This includes all required expenditure documentation. Additionally, a fiscal administrator has been assigned (Maria Battisti) to oversee accountant progress maintaining fiscal records.

All expenditures are separated by member and object code; members making expenditures assign to programs/objectives.

Reporting activities is reported by assigned grant director David Castillo with fiscal reporting entered by fiscal administrator. Report is reviewed and certified by Deputy Chancellor Ken Stoppenbrink.

No significant changes are noted as funding allocations will remain basically the same for year 2016-17. The slight increase for each member reflects the additional \$23,016 in total award amount.

The larger total amounts list above for West Hills College reflect like amounts per school, fiscal agent indirect, consortium focused staffing wages and benefits, supplies, and travel reimbursements for consortium related travel.
